MEETINGS ARE OPEN TO THE PUBLIC

A school board meeting is a meeting held in public; it is not a public meeting. That is why a special time is allowed on the agenda for citizen's comments. The Board may meet in closed session for a specific purpose, such as discussing legal matters, personnel or negotiations.
