What To Wear

Sneakers are required for marching, as open-toed shoes or sandals are dangerous. Students are also advised to wear light, loose fitting, school-appropriate clothing during these summer rehearsals. We will be outside most of the day.

What to Bring

Students should bring a water bottle, your instrument, your flip folder (see below), sunscreen, and a 1" binder. The binder will be used to hold drill charts and to mark your place on the field. Apply sunscreen in the morning, and be prepared to re-apply every few hours. Students should also bring a lunch with them.

Flip Folders & Lyres (upperclassmen should already have these!)

In preparation for High School band, students are asked to purchase a flip folder (plastic folio) and 20 pages (windows). Along with the flip folder/pages, students are asked to purchase a marching lyre (mini clip or stand that connects to your instrument to hold music while marching). These supplies are inexpensive (under \$30 total) and will be used throughout high school for marching and pep band. These supplies are also instrument specific. They can be fitted to your instrument and purchased at any music store. Please bring your instrument with you to make sure that the lyre fits your instrument.

Marching Uniforms

Wrightstown High School marching uniforms consist of a jacket (issued by school), black pants, black socks, black shoes, and marching berets (issued by school). The marching jackets and berets will be kept at school while not in use. Jacket fittings will take place after rehearsals on the following dates:
