Dear Parent/Guardian:

All juniors are required, by the state of Wisconsin, to take the ACT Plus Writing at 8:00 AM on Tuesday March 3, 2019. This assessment is important to students and families as it provides information about being college and career ready and planning next academic and career goals. Due to the length (approximately 4 ½ hours) of the assessment, the desire to have students take the assessment in small groups, and the site specific requirements for ACT, **freshmen, sophomores and seniors will not have school on Tuesday March 3<sup>rd</sup>** (busses will run as normal). Juniors will be dismissed for the remainder of the day after completing the testing.


By having only juniors in the building, we can have the students take the test in small groups with staff test proctors, and in a quiet environment with no bells or other students in the hallways. We believe this will allow our juniors to perform at their best on this important assessment.

Students will be registering for the test at school on February 26<sup>th</sup>. If appropriate, when students register for the ACT, they can indicate up to four colleges where their scores can be sent for free. There is no down side to sending the scores as your child can take the ACT multiple times and colleges will take the highest score. The down side to not sending them is, depending on the college, there may be a fee from ACT if you choose to send them at a later date.

In the event that there is inclement weather on March 3<sup>rd</sup> the make-up day for the ACT is March 17<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 am. If we do end up testing on the make-up day we will use the schedule outlined above. Parents of students in the junior class will receive an additional letter prior to the test date providing more information about the ACT.
