Board of Education Structure Board of Education Wrightstown Community School District

The Wrightstown Community School District Board of Education consists of seven (7) members, elected at large from the area served by the District. Eligibility to serve on the Board is set forth in state statute.

The Board of Education is elected to represent the 9 municipalities within the District.

Brown County: Town of Holland, Town of Lawrence, Town of Morrison, Town

of Rockland, Town of Wrightstown Calumet County: Town of Brillion

Outagamie County: Town of Buchanan, Town of Kaukauna, Village of

Wrightstown

Election to the Board shall be for three (3) years, with two positions elected on two successive years, and three positions elected on the third year. Elections will be on the 1st Tuesday of April. Requirements to meet candidate eligibility may be obtained from the Board Clerk or district office. A motion at the district annual meeting sets annual Board compensation.

Board officers shall consist of President, Vice-President, Treasurer, and Clerk/Secretary. They shall be elected by the Board members at the May organizational meeting, consistent with the first meeting for newly elected members.

Board members may act in their capacity only in a legally posted meeting with a majority (4) present. Individual members have no authority to act or speak on behalf of the entire Board. The Board operates as a committee of the whole, with both standing and ad hoc committees created by the Board as needed to support their work.

Board roles include: 1) development and adoption of District policy; 2) designation of a chief executive; 3) planning, setting, and updating District goals; 4) approving and adopting an annual budget; 5) determining school facility needs; along with other general activities including developing operating principles, electing officers, approving calendars, retaining a school attorney, working with other agencies, and establishing and maintain effective board-superintendent relations.
