Board of Education meetings are held for the purpose of the seven-member Board to conduct the business of the school district. School boards are required to hold a regular school board meeting each month.

Board of Education meetings are open and accessible to the members of the public. They are open to the public, but not public meetings.

The Wrightstown Community School District Board of Education meets on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesday of each month at 6:00PM in the elementary multi-purpose room, located in Wrightstown Elementary School.

Regular monthly meetings and meetings in which a majority of members are present to conduct business will be legally posted and notification given to media members in compliance with state statute and district policy. Notice of the meeting will be given at 24 hours in advance of the meeting. Meeting agendas and approved minutes will be posted in each district building and on the district website at <a href="https://www.wrightstown.k12.wi.us">www.wrightstown.k12.wi.us</a>. Meeting minutes will include the essential elements of official action taken by the Board including the subject matter of the motions, the persons making and seconding the motions, and the roll call vote on the motion. Efforts will be made to include a summary of information and comments from the collective Board members as well as any potential agenda items during the Meeting Summary portion of the Board meeting.
