

Communication with the Public

The Wrightstown Community School District Board believes that the public schools belong to the people who support them through taxation and should be reflective of the community they serve. Public schools are only as strong as the informed support of the public. Support must be based on understanding, knowledge, and participation in the efforts of the public schools. Every member of the Board and every employee of the district has a role in the development of a successful school-community relations program.

Meeting the needs of the community and gaining the support to meet those needs depends upon two-way communication between the Board and the public. The Board, therefore, will make every attempt to make known its plans and actions and encourage the community to make known its desires.

The District will use all channels of communication to keep citizens informed of policies, programs, and plans of the school district through the office of the District Administrator; invite advice and counsel of school district residents at the regular monthly meeting at a time so designated on the agenda; and solicit counsel of citizens through Board appointed advisory committees charged with specific tasks.
