

**Summer School
Board of Education
Wrightstown Community School District**

The Wrightstown Community School District believes all students should be offered a quality learning environment which maximizes their potential. The District may offer a summer achievement program occurring outside of the periods of regular instruction and which do not count towards the minimum hours of instruction required by law, for the purpose of academic instruction and/or recreational activities for resident students of this District.

Summer school instruction may be designed to provide opportunities for students to:

- A. complete course work
- B. improve learning skills
- C. make up a failed course
- D. enrich a scholastic program
- E. explore new academic areas

The Board shall annually approve a summer school program. In order to support such a program of instruction, the Board will:

- A. employ teaching and administrative staff
- B. purchase such books, materials, supplies, and equipment as may be necessary
- C. appoint the director
- D. make available school facilities as required
- E. provide necessary custodial services

Tuition fees shall not be charged to students within the District or for those students residing in the District even if they were not enrolled as residents during the most recent regular session. Tuition shall be charged for nonresident students at rates as determined by the Board.

Reasonable fees may be charged to all students for social, recreational, or extra-curricular summer or interim session classes in accordance with DPI regulations.

The District Administrator shall be responsible for developing administrative guidelines for the operation of the summer program which shall be consistent with Board policies and not conflict in any way with the administration of the regular school sessions of the District.
