High School Weighted Grading System Board of Education Wrightstown Community School District

The Wrightstown Community School District recognizes the advanced nature of certain courses that extend college level educational experiences for high school students. To recognize this level of work, expectations and difficulty, courses meeting established criteria by the College Board for Advanced Placement Curriculum shall be designated 'weighted courses' and shall have the marking and grading system weighted for grade point average purposes.

A weighted grading system will be used at Wrightstown High School. The grades that students earn in the following approved courses will be weighted:

AP United States History AP Psychology AP English Literature AP Physics AP Calculus AP Spanish

AP Chemistry AP Biology **AP Microeconomics**

Students will receive an additional .33 toward their grade point average for successful completion of these courses.
