The Wrightstown Community School District believes that it is important for all students to reach their potential as learners and meet the District's learning standards and benchmarks. In an effort to help disadvantaged students improve their academic achievement, the District shall participate in the federal Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA, 2015) Title I program and abide by all legal requirements for participation in such programs.

The services provided through Title I funds shall be supplemental to the services provided in the regular education classroom and other support programs. Services in these areas will be at least comparable to the services provided in areas not receiving Title I federal funds. Title I services are available to students who attend school in both public and private schools.

The District recognizes the importance of parent and teacher involvement in the Title I program and will provide appropriate opportunities for parents and teachers to become involved in the design and implementation of the district's ESSA Title I program.
