

**Technology Policy Regarding Students with Special Needs**

**Wrightstown Community School District**

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The Wrightstown Community School District aims to provide special education and related services designed to meet the unique needs of each student with a disability, based on his/her individualized education program (IEP). Related services, assistive technology devices and assistive technology services will be determined by the IEP team in compliance with Wisconsin Statutes 115 (V) and Individuals with Disabilities Act Reauthorization of July 2005.

Those students having special needs but not requiring a formal IEP according to law, which may include but are not limited to migrant students, homeless students, students living with poverty, students with 504 plans, and English Language Learners, will also be considered for assistive technology devices and/or services on an individual basis.
