The Board has established a Senior Release Privilege opportunity to recognize senior students who have demonstrated a high level of maturity and personal responsibility.

Wrightstown High School offers seniors, who are on track for graduation, have taken all necessary and required courses, and are in good standing academically (defined as having at least a 1.67 GPA and no failing marks for the previous grading period), the opportunity to be excused from either first or fourth block study hall with parental permission. The seniors are eligible to arrive at school before the second academic block or leave following the third academic block.

This opportunity will be revoked for the remainder of the current semester in the event of any unexcused absence or the accumulation of more than five tardies per semester. The high school principal or his/her designee reserves the right to discontinue privilege for any other reason that he/she see fit.
