

**Student Alcohol & Other Drug Use Policy**  
**Board of Education**  
**Wrightstown Community School District**

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The Wrightstown Community School District strives to promote a safe and healthy environment for students, teachers, and district employees. In accordance with state law, Wis. Statutes 125.07 & 125.09, the District recognizes that student involvement with alcohol, tobacco, and other drugs hampers their educational success, can damage the health and well-being of our students and is illegal.

Students are prohibited from the:

- manufacture
- distribution (including sale or intent to distribute)
- possession
- use

of an illegal substance, controlled substance, drug paraphernalia, other mood or mind-altering substances (e.g., inhalants) or alcohol while on District property or at any District-approved activity or function off school property.

For the purposes of this policy, smokeless tobacco, cigars, cigarettes, pipe tobacco, chewing tobacco, snuff, electronic/vapor cigarettes, clove cigarettes, or other lighted smoking devices for burning tobacco, oils, or any other substances are prohibited. Electronic and vapor products including electronic hookah, heating elements, power sources, or any other electronic, chemical or mechanical means used to produce vapor that is inhaled by the user is prohibited.

Prescription medication being taken by students for whom the medication has been prescribed is exempt from this provision.

The District recognizes its role in supporting parents in their responsibility to educate students regarding the immediate, intermediate and long-term effects of alcohol and other drug use. The District also encourages the use of community resources in dealing with alcohol or other drug use issues.
