## Administrative Guidelines Student Alcohol & Other Drug Use Policy Board of Education Wrightstown Community School District

### ENFORCEMENT PROCEDURES FOR STUDENT ALCOHOL AND OTHER DRUG USE POLICY VIOLATIONS

If a designated school official or law enforcement officer has reasonable suspicion that a student is under the influence of alcohol or drugs in violation of this policy and implementing rule, a student may be required to submit to a breath test or another form of drug test to determine the presence of alcohol or drugs. The District also reserves the right to search lockers, personal property, or vehicles in the school district lot if there is reasonable suspicion of possession of alcohol or other drugs. Such test shall be administered by a law enforcement officer and shall meet state law requirements. A student refusing to submit to such test will be assumed to be in violation of the policy.

A student found to be in violation of this policy will have sanctions placed on their eligibility to participate in athletic and co-curricular activities. These disciplinary procedures are outlined in the Co-Curricular Code Policy.

The administration will take the following steps when the Board's Student Alcohol and Other Drug Use Policy is violated:

#### **Violations**

 Suspected of using or being under the influence of intoxicants (including alcohol), drugs or inhalants and/or refusing a breath test;

Cases will be handled on an individual basis using the following sanctions:

- 1. Contact parent or quardian
- 2. Suspension
- 3. Referral to AODA resources
- 4. Contact Law Enforcement

#### b. Possession of drug paraphernalia

Cases will be handled on an individual basis using the following sanctions:

- 1. Contact parent or guardian
- 2. Suspension
- 3. Referral to AODA resources
- 4. Confiscate paraphernalia
- 5. Contact Law Enforcement
- 6. May recommend pre-expulsion

### c. Possession or use of intoxicants (including alcohol), drugs, lookalike drugs or inhalants, or misuse of products containing alcohol

Cases will be handled on an individual basis using the following sanctions:

- 1. Contact parent or guardian
- 2. Suspension
- 3. Referral to AODA resources
- 4. Confiscate intoxicants
- 5. Contact Law Enforcement
- 6. May recommend pre-expulsion/expulsion

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## d. Selling and/or distribution and/or intent to distribute intoxicants (including alcohol), drugs (including look-alike drugs) or inhalants

Cases will be handled using the following sanctions:

- 1. Contact parent or quardian
- 2. Suspension pending expulsion proceedings
- 3. Referral to AODA resources
- 4. Confiscate intoxicants, drugs or inhalants
- 5. Contact Law Enforcement
- 6. Refer to Wrightstown Board of Education for expulsion

A **Second Violation** of the Student Alcohol and Other Drug Use Policy will result in the following sanctions:

- 1. Contact parent or guardian
- 2. Suspension from school
- 3. Referral to AODA resources
- 4. Confiscate intoxicants, drugs, paraphernalia, or inhalants
- 5. Contact Law Enforcement
- 6. May recommend pre-expulsion or expulsion

A **Third Violation** of the Board's Student Alcohol and Other Drug Use Policy will result in immediate referral to the Board for expulsion.
