Budget Hearing Board of Education Wrightstown Community School District

The annual budget adopted by the Wrightstown Community School District represents the Board of Education's position on the allocation of resources required to operate an appropriate system of education. All reasonable means will be employed by the Board to present and explain that position to all interested parties. A public budget hearing will be conducted at the annual meeting. The report will include the budget summary required under s. 65.90 of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Each member of the Board, the District Administrator, and the District Business Manager shall be sufficiently acquainted with the budget and its underlying purposes to answer questions from members of the public.

A simplified form of the budget may be prepared annually and may be sent to appropriate parties and distributed to each person attending the annual budget hearing.

The final budget approved by the Board shall be made available to the public in the form and places as required by law.
