Lead Paint Management Board of Education Wrightstown Community School District

The Wrightstown Community School District is committed to ensuring a safe and healthy environment for staff, students, and community members. As part of the Indoor Environmental Management Plan, the district is committed to protecting employees and students from the hazards of lead-based paint.

For all District facilities built before 1978, all work areas where there is the potential for lead paint or other lead containing materials will be presumed to be positive unless an inspection report or sample results prove otherwise. For large projects, a lead survey or inspection will be done by a certified environmental firm as part of the overall hazardous materials survey done prior to construction activities.

The District will work to ensure that all building and grounds employees are aware of the hazards and use work practices that comply with the OSHA Lead in Construction Standard, 29 CFR 1926.62 or when applicable, the EPA/MA Renovation, Repair and Painting (RRP) rule when preforming tasks that have the potential to disturb lead-based paint. Outside contractors will be responsible for complying with these regulations when applicable, as MA DPH Lead Prevention and Control (105 CMR 460.000) and MA DOS De-leading regulations (\$%\$ CMR 22.00) when preforming lead abatement.
