The Wrightstown Community School District is committed to ensuring energy management initiatives that minimize the impact of energy cost increases on the budget, maintain a reliable source of energy, meet the functional needs of the District, and ensure that energy is used efficiently.

A strong commitment on the part of the District is important to an effective energy management program. It is the responsibility of each District employee to actively participate in conservation efforts in order to reduce consumption to levels prescribed by state, federal, and local rules. Every effort will be made to ensure that staff receive information regarding energy conservation.

All operations of the District facilities will be governed by established energy management guidelines that are designed to save scarce resources without infringement of the educational mission of the District.

The Director of Building and Grounds will implement, direct, monitor, and evaluate energy management efforts. Regular energy audits will be conducted to gather energy management data. The Director of Business Services will monitor fiscal implications for energy conservation efforts. Energy grants and energy cost-management strategies will be explored to maximize any cost saving efforts. Energy management efforts will be reported to the District Administrator, who will communicate these efforts to the Board of Education as requested.
