

# History of the Earl A. Heyrman Scholarship Foundation

In 1997, Earl A. Heyrman, President of Heyrman Construction Company, Inc., Green Bay, WI created a scholarship foundation to provide financial assistance to graduates from accredited high schools in Brown, Door, Oconto, Outagamie, Keweenaw & Marinette Counties.

Applicants must pursue a degree in :

• **Civil, Architectural, Mechanical or Electrical Engineering**

Or

• **Architecture**

The number of scholarships and the amount of the award for each year shall be determined by the Trustees. Normally one thousand dollars a year for four years will be provided if a B average is maintained.

## Qualifying Colleges

Scholarships are awarded to recipients attending Milwaukee School of Engineering, Michigan Technological University, University of Wisconsin-Madison, Milwaukee and Platteville, Marquette University and the University of Minnesota.

## Scholarship Guidelines

1. Applications and financial aid forms are available from the high school guidance counselors.
2. The completed application form, personal statement and a copy of Part One of the Student Aid Report (S.A.R.) which can be received from the Federal Processor, must be sent to the Foundation by April 1<sup>st</sup> or sooner.
3. Scholarship winners will be announced about May 1<sup>st</sup>.
4. A \$500 award will be sent to the respective college in August and January.
5. To be eligible for continued awards, recipients are required to;
  - a. Attend a qualifying college on a full-time basis.
  - b. Report grades attained within two weeks of the end of each semester including a statement of your intended qualifying degree.
  - c. Notify the Foundation of any changes in financial need.
  - d. Advise the Foundation if you will not be attending college the following semester.
  - e. Notify the Foundation if you are transferring colleges.
6. Should a recipient of the Heyrman Foundation Scholarship receive assistance from other sources, all or part of the aid from this Foundation may be withdrawn or discontinued, depending on financial need.
7. The scholarship can be used only for tuition, books, fees, supplies and equipment required at the college.
