

Purpose

The Fox River Valley Branch of the Wisconsin Section of the American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE) provides scholarships to high school and university/technical school students who are pursuing degrees in Civil Engineering and/or a Civil Engineering related field.

Entry Requirements

Applicants **must** submit:

- Completed application form.
- Proposed curriculum of study (i.e. list of courses that have been or will be taken during the course of the pursued curriculum) and how it relates to civil engineering.
- One page essay on educational plans and career objectives.
- Resume that includes all schools, colleges and/or universities attended; dates attended, major/field(s) of study, grade point average, degrees received, work experience, civic work/community involvement, and/or extracurricular activities.
- Unofficial transcripts.

Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Eligibility Categories

Category A – High School Senior Pursuing a degree in Civil Engineering

- Enrolling full time in an ABET-accredited university or college for the fall 2018 semester.
- Pursuing an undergraduate degree in Civil Engineering.
- Applicant must be a U.S. citizen and Wisconsin resident.

Category B – High School Senior Pursuing a degree in a Civil Engineering related field

- Enrolling full time in a university, college, or technical school for fall 2018 semester.
- Pursuing an undergraduate degree relevant to Civil Engineering, but not specifically a Civil Engineering degree.

- Applicant must be a U.S. citizen and Wisconsin resident.

Category C- Existing College Student

- Enrolled full time in a university, college, or technical school for both the Spring 2017 and Fall 2018 semesters.
- Pursuing an undergraduate or graduate degree relevant to Civil Engineering.
- Applicant must be a U.S. citizen and Wisconsin resident.

Selection Criteria

A selection committee will evaluate the applications and select the recipients based on quality of the academic records, career objectives, and extracurricular activities. All applicants are considered without regard to color, gender, race, creed, or country of origin.

Support Provided

The scholarships will provide a one-time grant to the most outstanding applicant(s) meeting the eligibility requirements in each of the three eligibility categories. The funds will be disbursed as follows, depending on the eligibility category met:

1. Category A – **(1) \$1,000 Scholarship**
2. Category B – **(1) \$1,000 Scholarship**
3. Category C – **(1) \$1,000 Scholarship**

In the event that a category receives no qualified applicants, the Scholarship Committee may award the scholarship to the next highest-scoring candidate in either of the two other categories. In the event that there are extra funds available and there are well-qualified candidates, the Scholarship Committee may grant additional awards to the next most qualified candidates.

Funds will be disbursed directly to the financial office of the recipient's school upon verification of enrollment.
