WHAT'S NEW?

District planning meetings continued in the last month with District leadership, Bray, and Miron. These meetings focused on planning the integration of classroom technology within each of the spaces. One of the projects goal's is to make the technology flexible so the District can adapt as changes are made in the future.

Elementary and middle school furniture planning kicked-off this month. This process will be begin by accessing existing reusable furniture as well as prioritizing which spaces should receive new furniture.

WHAT'S NEXT?

- Meetings will continue as Bray and the District sort through final plan details and coordinate mechanical, electrical, and plumbing systems.
- A progress set of construction documents (plan drawings) will be over 90% complete in early January. Final engineer coordination meetings will occur in early January.
- Final design drawings will be complete February 4, with a public bid process to follow.
- The groundbreaking for the elementary and middle school projects will occur in Spring 2021, weather permitting.

Planning & Design Highlights

- The project team discussed relocation of the existing internet utility connection that runs between the middle and elementary school. This connection will need to be relocated in order for the addition and site improvements to be made.
- The utility relocation needs to coincide with the timing of construction to be able to maintain internet services for all district buildings.
- Bray and the District discussed exterior signage goals for the elementary and middle schools.
- Bray and the District continue to refine the exterior material samples for the elementary and middle schools. This includes the selection of an accent brick to compliment the existing brick.
- Bray and elementary staff coordinated final quantity and location of marker and tack boards are being planned for in each space.
- At the December 14 plan review meeting, the Village of Wrightstown approved the plans.
