NURSE NOTES Please keep your child at home if they are sick!

- It is recommended that students be fever-free (less than 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit without the use of antipyretic medication) for 24 hours before returning to school.
- Vomiting: Students may return to school 24 hours following the last episode of vomiting if fever has resolved and no other symptoms have developed.
