ESEA (Elementary and Secondary Education Act)

The Wrightstown Community School District has many fine teachers, and you have a chance to learn more about them. The Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) requires schools to offer parents with children in Title I schools additional information about the teaching staff each year. Specifically, we want you to know you have the right to ask for information about

- 1. The professional qualifications of your child's classroom teacher, including:
 - a. whether the teacher has met Wisconsin licensing criteria to serve the grade assigned,
 - b. whether the teacher is teaching under an emergency or provisional status,
 - c. the undergraduate and graduate field of study of the teacher.
- 2. The professional qualifications of a paraprofessional providing services to your child.
