WORK PERMIT INFORMATION

As you may have heard, the Department of Workforce Development's Equal Rights Division has developed a new online work permit application tool. The Division carefully considered the lessons of the past few years, when pandemic restrictions made it nearly impossible for some minors to obtain work permits and decided to pursue an online application that would be available to the parents of minors 24 hours a day, 7 days a week from any computer, tablet, smartphone, or similar device. The application improves accessibility for minors who live in rural or underserved areas and eliminates the difficult logistics involved in working parents having to take off work to make a trip to a work permit office.

Parents can access the site **using these instructions**. Payment is made directly to the department through the application, using a credit or debit card or by ACH direct withdrawal. Once the permit application process is complete, the Department mails a paper copy of the permit directly to the employer.

ATHLETIC AND NON-ATHLETIC ACTIVITY REGISTRATION

The school year is in full swing!

If you haven't done so already, please complete your son/daughter's registration as soon as possible! This will allow the coaches/advisors to contact you. Without registration, your son/daughter will not be allowed to participate.

Returning User: Login to your family's account as a returning user, click "Register" to complete the steps and submit registration. The form will auto-populate the answers based on your previously submitted registration. Please review and edit the answers as needed.

New User: Parents/guardians will create a family account, register their son/daughter for their activity and complete the required steps. For WHS students, the Student ID is your child's 6-digit Skyward ID.

<u>Physicals</u>: Students registering for <u>athletics</u> must have a current physical exam form uploaded to the activity portal before the student is authorized to participate in tryouts/practice. If you are unable to upload the form, you can bring the form to school and we can upload it for you.

Bellin FastCare locations in Green Bay are currently offering sports physical walk ups for \$20. Please bring the <u>sports physical form</u> to be completed by the doctor. To ensure clearance for participation, physicals should be completed and uploaded to this account no later than 3 school days prior to the first day of practice/tryouts.
