CLUBS AND ACTIVITY PARTICIPATION – Code of Conduct Needed

High school students, along with a parent or guardian, who plan on participating in any co-curricular <u>clubs/activities</u> (non-sport) offered during this school year, need to complete the <u>Code of Conduct Google Form</u>. (Example: FFA, Esports, Forensics, etc...) Although you may have completed the code of conduct for athletics, this is specific to Group II (non-sport) Activities. Please have this completed as soon as possible so your student can participate.

ATHLETICS REGISTRATION

High school students who plan on participating in any <u>athletic sports</u> offered throughout the school year, need to be registered in the <u>Activity Registration Portal</u>. Your registration will allow the coaches to contact you. Without registration, your son/daughter will not be allowed to participate.

Parents/guardians will create a family account, register their son/daughter for their activity and complete the required steps. Please be sure to choose the correct registration form. The Student ID is your child's 6-digit Skyward ID. The code of conduct is part of the athletics registration process. The process will need to be done each school year using the same family account.

Students registering for athletics must have a current physical exam form uploaded to the activity portal before the student is authorized to participate in tryouts/practice. A physical exam taken April 1 and after is valid for the following 2 school years; a physical exam taken before April 1 is valid only for the remainder of that school year and the following school year. To ensure clearance for participation, physicals should be completed and uploaded to this account no later than 3 school days prior to the first day of practice/tryouts.

Bellin FastCare locations in Green Bay are currently offering sports physical walk ups for \$20. Please bring the <u>sports physical form</u> to be completed by the doctor.
