WORK PERMIT INFORMATION

As you may have heard, the Department of Workforce Development's Equal Rights Division has developed a new online work permit application tool. The Division carefully considered the lessons of the past few years, when pandemic restrictions made it nearly impossible for some minors to obtain work permits and decided to pursue an online application that would be available to the parents of minors 24 hours a day, 7 days a week from any computer, tablet, smartphone, or similar device. The application improves accessibility for minors who live in rural or underserved areas and eliminates the difficult logistics involved in working parents having to take off work to make a trip to a work permit office.

Parents can access the site [using these instructions](#). Payment is made directly to the department through the application, using a credit or debit card or by ACH direct withdrawal. Once the permit application process is complete, the Department mails a paper copy of the permit directly to the employer.

Transcripts

If the post-secondary school you are applying to requests an official transcript, students will send that request via the Parchment website. Please refer to the link <https://www.parchment.com> create an account using a PERSONAL email address and order with a credit or debit card. You will select the destination of where you would like the transcript sent. The transcript is then sent directly to that destination electronically. There is no need to pay for a self-view copy as you are able to view your transcript on your dashboard in Parchment. Post-secondary schools will not accept an official transcript when it is provided directly from a student.

Unofficial Transcripts: Seniors have access to their *unofficial* transcript in Skyward (Portfolio/attachments). If your post-secondary school accepts an unofficial transcript, you can provide them with a copy. If they will only accept a copy from WHS directly, please contact the Counseling Office.

You can also use the unofficial transcript copy for college visits and for applying for scholarships.

2023-24 WHS ATHLETIC/ACTIVITY REGISTRATION

If your child plans on participating in any athletics or activities offered during the school year, you will need to register them using this link: [Activity Registration Portal](#). Please be sure to choose the correct registration form. The student will need to complete the code of conduct portion along with you.

If you haven't done so already, please have registration completed as soon as possible! Your registration will allow the coaches to contact you. Without registration, your son/daughter will not be allowed to participate.

Returning User: Login to your family's account as a returning user, click "Register" to complete the steps and submit registration. The form will auto-populate the answers based on your previously submitted registration. Please review and edit the answers as needed.

New User: Parents/guardians will create a family account, register their son/daughter for their activity and complete the required steps. For WHS students, the Student ID is your child's 6-digit Skyward ID.

The process will need to be done each school year using the same family account.

Physicals: Students registering for athletics must have a current physical exam form uploaded to the activity portal before the student is authorized to participate in tryouts/practice. If you are unable to upload the form, you can bring the form to school and we can upload it for you. Bellin FastCare locations in Green Bay are currently offering sports physical walk ups for \$20. Please bring the [sports physical form](#) to be completed by the doctor. To ensure clearance for participation, physicals should be completed and uploaded to this account no later than 3 school days prior to the first day of practice/tryouts. **A physical exam taken April 1 and after is valid for the following 2 school years; a physical exam taken before April 1 is valid only for the remainder of that school year and the following school year.**
