History of the Earl A. Heyrman Scholarship Foundation

In 1997, Earl A. Heyrman, President of Heyrman Construction Company, Inc., Green Bay, WI created a scholarship foundation to provide financial assistance to graduates from accredited high schools in Brown, Door, Oconto, Outagamie, Kewanee & Marinette Counties.

Applicants must pursue a degree in :

• Civil, Architectural, Mechanical or Electrical Engineering

Or

Architecture

The number of scholarships and the amount of the award for each year shall be determined by the Trustees. Normally one thousand dollars a year for four years will be provided if a B average is maintained.

Qualifying Colleges

Scholarships are awarded to recipients attending Milwaukee School of Engineering, Michigan Technological University, University of Wisconsin-Madison, Milwaukee and Platteville, Marquette University and the University of Minnesota.

Scholarship Guidelines

- 1. Applications and financial aid forms are available from the high school guidance counselors.
- 2. The completed application form, personal statement and a copy of Part One of the Student Aid Report (S.A.R.) which can be received from the Federal Processor, must be sent to the Foundation by April 1st or sooner.
- 3. Scholarship winners will be announced about May 1st.
- 4. A \$500 award will be sent to the respective college in August and January.
- 5. To be eligible for continued awards, recipients are required to;
 - a. Attend a qualifying college on a full-time basis.
- b. Report grades attained within two weeks of the end of each semester including a statement of your intended qualifying degree.
- c. Notify the Foundation of any changes in financial need.
- d. Advise the Foundation if you will not be attending college the following semester.
- e. Notify the Foundation if you are transferring colleges.
- 6. Should a recipient of the Heyrman Foundation Scholarship receive assistance from other sources, all or part of the aid from this Foundation may be withdrawn or discontinued, depending on financial need.
- 7. The scholarship can be used only for tuition, books, fees, supplies and equipment required at the college.
