

# Chris Reichwald Memorial Scholarship

Chris Reichwald attended Wrightstown High School from 1995 to 1997. Chris was an avid golfer, playing varsity golf and earning letters in both his freshman and sophomore years. In the fall of his junior year, Chris died in a tragic automobile accident while crossing Highway 41. His death influenced the community to create the Highway 41 LAWS (Lives Are Worth Saving) Committee, which ultimately succeeded in convincing state and national highway officials to upgrade Highway 41 to freeway status.

This scholarship fund was established by Chris's parents, Carla and Harry Reichwald, to memorialize his life and to reward future Wrightstown High School students aspiring to continue their education at a college or university.

## Two Scholarships @ \$1,500 each

**\* One award is for a senior who is a member of the golf team (boys or girls) with a preference given to a student who meets the following criteria:**

- Varsity Golfer (letter winner)
- Highest GPA, minimum 3.0
- Attending a college or university the year following high school graduation
- Payment upon proof of enrollment

**\* One award is for a senior, with preference given to a student who meets the following criteria:**

- Minimum 3.0 GPA
- Student who hasn't received any other scholarships
- Candidates must have applied for other scholarships
- Recipient to be chosen from available candidates by scholarship selection committee based on merit
- Attending a college or university the year following high school graduation
- Payment upon proof of enrollment

**To Apply:** Submit a list of the activities you have participated in and the name of at least one scholarship you have applied for.

**Deadline Date: April 15th**
