

Appleton Area Jaycees Scholarship

Purpose: To recognize individuals in the area who are making an impact in the community.

Scholarship Reward: Two individuals will receive awards of \$500 to defray the costs of higher education. One \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a 2019 high school graduate. The other \$500 scholarship will be awarded to an individual who is between the ages of 21 and 39. The Appleton Area Jaycees Board will review applications and determine the award winners.

2019 Appleton Jaycees High School Graduate Scholarship Eligibility Requirements

- Graduate from an Appleton area (Generally Oshkosh through De Pere) high school during the spring of 2019
- Be committed to service and leadership
- Have a record of displaying positive change in the Appleton and/or Fox Cities community

2019 Appleton Jaycee Community Scholarship Eligibility Requirements

- Be between the ages of 21 and 39 during the Fall 2019 semester
- Be attending a college or university in the Appleton area (Generally Oshkosh through De Pere) during the 2019 - 2020 academic year
- Be committed to service and leadership
- Have a record of displaying positive change in the Appleton and/or Fox Cities community
- Current Appleton Area Jaycee members are not eligible to apply for the scholarship
- The scholarship winner will also be awarded a one year membership to Appleton Area Jaycees. The membership can be renewed at no cost based on accumulation of membership points and the age of the member.

Additional Eligibility Information (Applicable to Both Scholarships)

- These scholarships are open to all regardless of race, color, religion, gender, gender expression, national origin, disability, marital status, and sexual orientation. These statuses will not improve or diminish the chances of being selected for a scholarship.

Deadline

- Applications can be submitted by emailing a completed application to appleton.jaycees@gmail.com by March 31, 2019. Applications submitted after the deadline will not be considered.

Review Process

- Applications will be reviewed and determined by the Appleton Area Jaycees Scholarship Committee. Award winners will be notified on or before April 30, 2019. Awards will be sent to the student's selected university or college with directions that the respective award be used to offset the student's higher education costs. Appleton Jaycees reserves the right to determine the final eligibility of scholarship candidates.
